Statement

The statement outlines the policies and practices to be followed to protect your personal information based on the requirements in the Personal Information Protection and Electronics Documents Act (PIPEDA). Personal Information

Our digital newsletter and email campaigns are managed using Mailchimp. Mailchimp collects subscriber data including device information and usage data.
